REMEMBER!

Regular verbs:

Positive:  + verb(ed/d) → He liked chocolate.

Negative:  + didn't+verb (infinitive) → He didn't like chocolate.

Questions: (Wh) Did+  + verb (infinitive)? → Did he like chocolate?/ What did he like?

Irregular verbs:

Positive:  + verb (2nd column) → He went to the park.

Negative:  + didn't+ verb (infinitive) → He didn't go to the park.

Questions: (Wh) Did+  + verb (infinitive)? → Did he go to the park? / Where did he go?
