

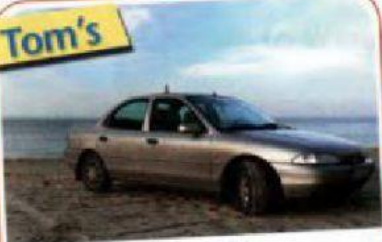


Comparative and superlative

John's



price : £7,000
speed: 90 mph
size: small
petrol consumption: low
made in 1987

Carol's



price : £19,000
speed: 130 mph
size: large
petrol consumption: high
made in 2006
