He packs away his equipment into his rocket.

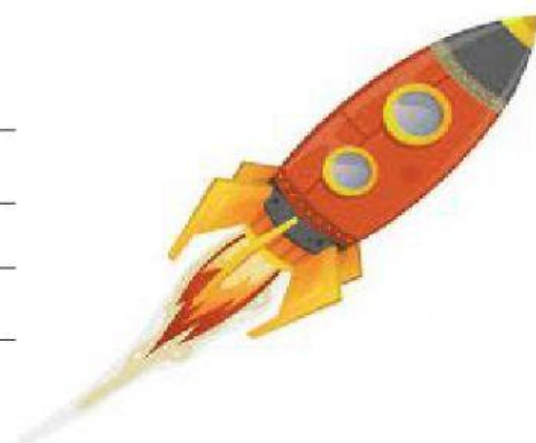
He cleans and tidies the moon.
