



## ≡ STRUCTURE ≡

- \* **AFFIRMATIVE** ---> Subject + will + verb (inf..) + complement + .
- \* **INTERROGATIVE** ---> Will + Subject + verb (inf..) + complement + ?
- \* **NEGATIVE** ---> Subject + won't (will not) + verb (inf..) + complement + .

### ● EXAMPLES ●

- \* He **will** be very famous!
- \* **Will** you go to the movies with me?
- \* She **won't** go to the party tomorrow.

## ≡ VOCABULARY ≡



- \* **Great:** Very good or very effective; excellent.
- \* **Party:** A social event at which a group of people meet.
- \* **Come:** To get to a particular place.
- \* **Win:** To achieve first position and/or get a prize in a competition, election, fight, etc..
- \* **Carry:** To move someone or something from one place to another.
- \* **Participate:** To take part in or become involved in an activity
- \* **Beauty contest:** a competition in which women are judged on how physically attractive they are.
- \* **Vet:** A person with a medical degree trained to take care of the health of animals
- \* **Able:** Intelligent or good at what you do.
