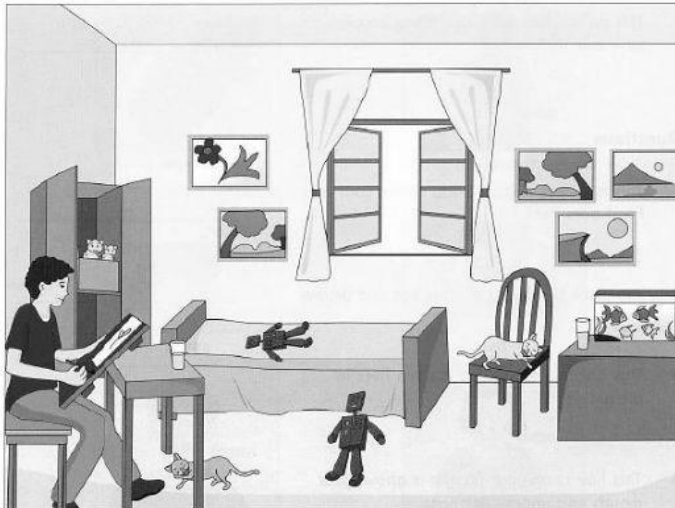
Molly

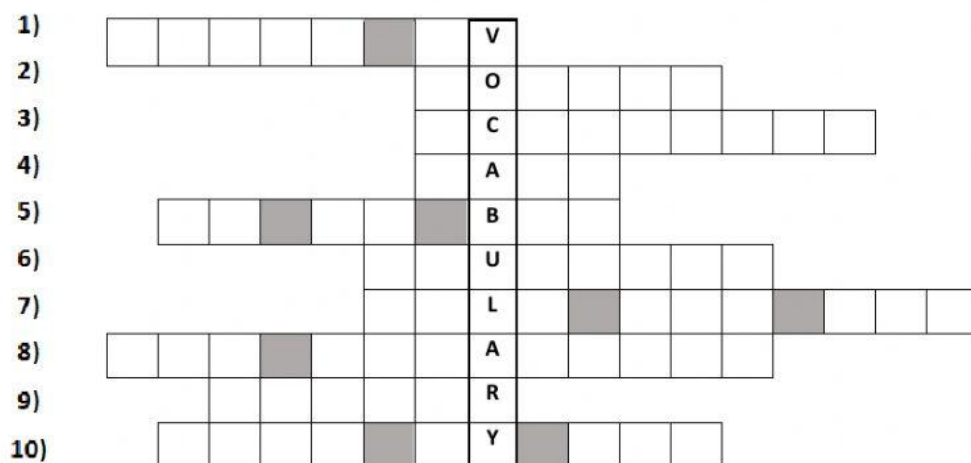
