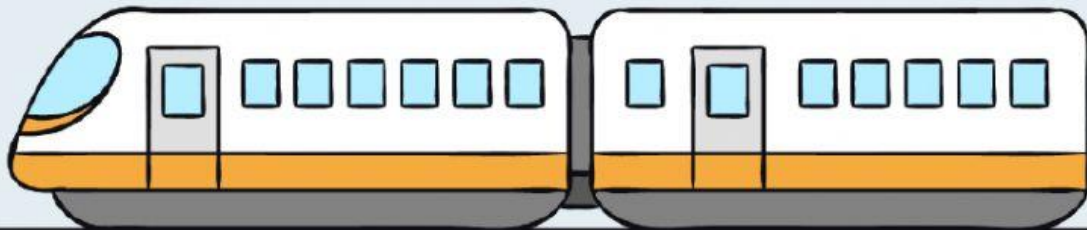

A / AN RULE

The **rule** applies to the sound of the letter beginning the word, not just the letter itself.

2

A OR AN?

If the word begins with a vowel sound, you must **use** an.

3

A OR AN?

If it begins with a consonant sound, you must **use** a.

PLURAL S RULE

If the singular noun ends in **-s**, **-ss**, **-sh**, **-ch**, **-x**, or **-z**, add **-es** to the end to make it **plural**.

2

PLURAL S RULE

If the noun ends with **-f** or **-fe**, the **f** is often changed to **-ves** to make it plural.

3

PLURAL S RULE

If a noun ends in **-y** and the letter before the **-y** is a consonant, drop **-y** and add **-ies**.
