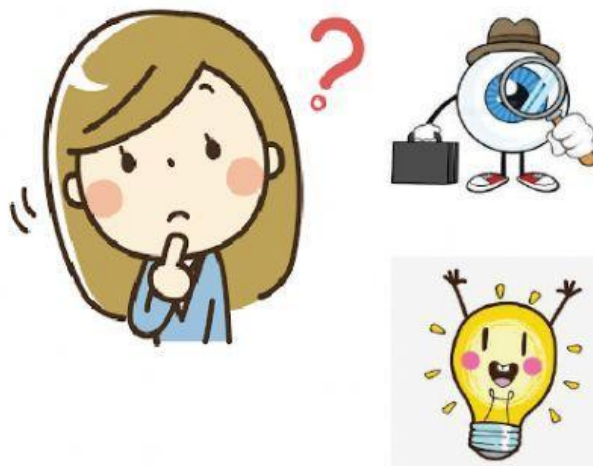


GRAMMAR SNACK: SIMPLE PRESENT

Use Present Simple to talk about: - repeated actions or daily routines I feed my dog twice a day. - permanent states Maggie lives in a detached house. - general truths or laws of nature Water freezes at 0 C.	Common time expressions: every day/week/month year, every morning/ afternoon/evening/ night, in the morning/ afternoon/evening, at night, on Mondays/ Tuesdays, etc.
