

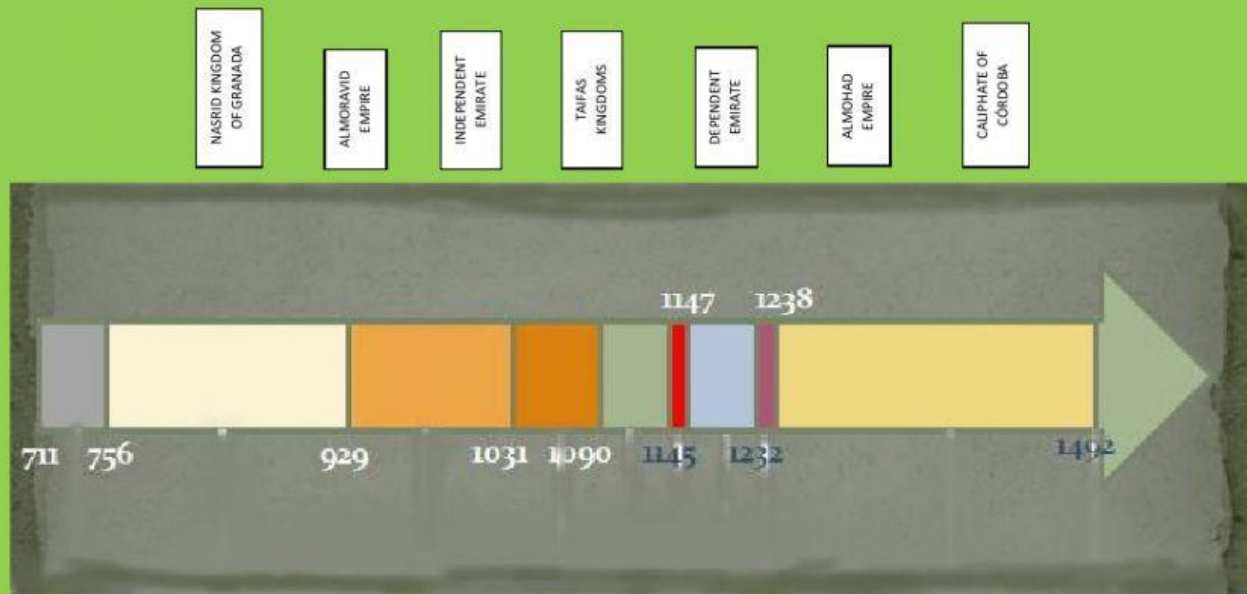

| - Al- Mansur | - First caliph of Córdoba. |
| - Abd-al-Rahman III | - Only survivor of the Umayyad dynasty who declared Al-Andalus an independent emirate. |
| - Muhammad XII | - Muslim general who controlled the Caliphate during Hisham II's reign. |
| - Tariq ibn Ziyad | - Last monarch of the Nasrid Kingdom of Granada |
| - Abd-al-Rahman I | - One of the Muslim generals who conquered the Iberian Peninsula in 711. |
| - Al-Hakam II | - Second caliph of Córdoba, who owned a library of more than 400, 000 books. |
