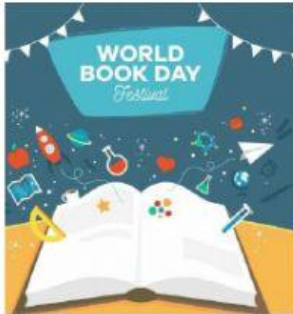
World Book Day- By Ross Lewis

WHEN IS WORLD BOOK DAY?

WHAT IS WORLD BOOK DAY?

It's not a normal day in school. Children celebrate famous books, characters, stories and writers from all around the world.
