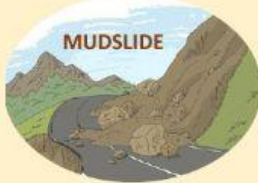
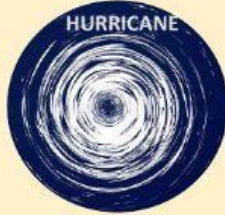


Natural disasters:

Heavy rainfall, global warming, overflow of the level of water, hurricanes, tsunamis.



Heating of the internal magma, it finds its way through the volcanoes.

Property destruction, contamination of water causing diseases, destruction of crops.



A system of higher atmospheric pressure, climate change, hot weather

Floods, destruction and damage, death and long lasting psychological.



Hyperthermia, dehydration, deaths, wildfires, power issues

Earthquakes, submarine landslides, strong volcanic eruptions, collision from meteorites

Human deaths, burns, fires, earthquakes, tsunamis, landslides. Ashes can pollute water, crops and the atmosphere.
