| Are they at home?       | Yes, they are/ No, they aren't. |
| Is it time for class?   | Yes, it is/ No, it isn't.       |
| Are you from São Paulo? | Yes, I am/ No, I'm not.         |

B: Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.

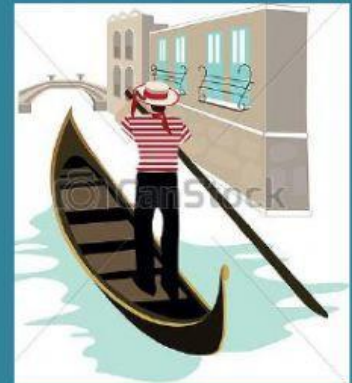


A: Is it time for lunch/dinner?
