Plans and intentions

Negative form:

Subject	+	Verb to be	+	Not	+	Going to	+	Verb
I		am		not		going to		verb
You		are		not		going to		verb
He		is		not		going to		verb
She		is		not		going to		verb
It		is		not		going to		verb
We		are		not		going to		verb
They		are		not		going to		verb

Example:

Subject + am + not + going to + verb + complement



I + am + not + going to + take + a bath

I am not going to take a bath

<u>I am not</u>	=	<u>I'm not</u>
<u>You are not</u>	=	<u>you aren't</u>
<u>He is not</u>	=	<u>he isn't</u>
<u>She is not</u>	=	<u>she isn't</u>
<u>It is not</u>	=	<u>It isn't</u>
<u>We are not</u>	=	<u>we aren't</u>
<u>They are not</u>	=	<u>they aren't</u>
