Example

I can use this shorter method:

① Multiply the ones.

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ \times 4 \\ \hline 8 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

② Multiply the tens.

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ \times 4 \\ \hline 48 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
