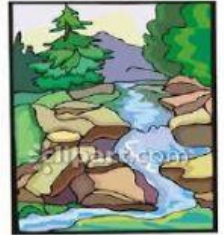

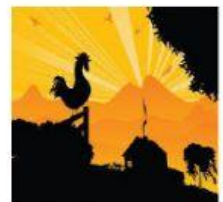

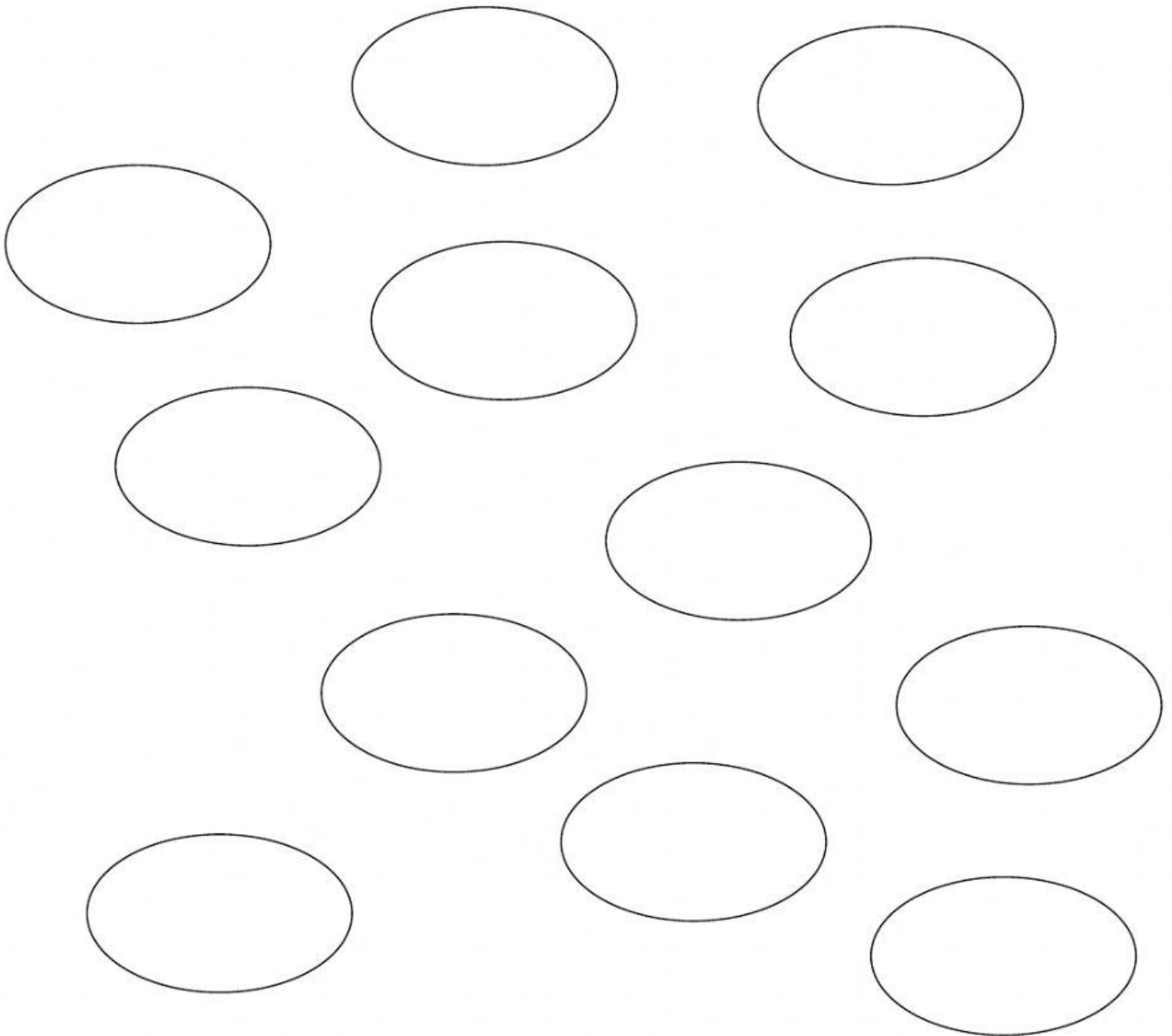


Diagram showing ten empty ovals arranged in a circular pattern, intended for students to write action words from the story.

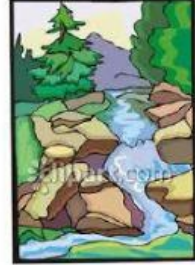
