

ABBREVIATIONS AND ACRONYMS

ABBREVIATIONS: Formed by shortening of words or lengthy phrases

Ex. PM – Prime Minister. They are not pronounced as new words.

ACRONYMS: a new word is formed from the first letters of a long name or phrase. Ex. NATO – North Atlantic Treaty Organisation.

All the **ACRONYMS** are **ABBREVIATIONS**

but not every **ABBREVIATIONS** is an **ACRONYM**.
