Amazing animals



The cheetah

They can run at speeds of between 112 and 120 kilometers per hour. They live mainly in Africa but also in Asia. Their fur is light brown or yellow with round black spots. They have claws. In a zoo they can live for 17 years. Most of them weigh between 50 and 60 kilograms. They are about 80 cm tall and about 140 cm long. They live alone or in pairs. They eat a variety of small animals.



The koala

Koalas live in Australia. They are small animals. They weigh about 13 kilograms and are usually about 50 cm tall. Koalas have soft grey and white fur. They live in forests and eat the leaves of trees. Koalas can live as long as 17 years. They move around at night and can sleep for 16 hours a day! They don't live in big groups but prefer to be alone. A koala can run as fast as a rabbit – about 55 kilometers per hour.



The blue whale

Blue whales are the largest animals on Earth. They can be 30 meters long and weigh 170 tons. They eat tiny animals in the sea called krill. Blue whales live in oceans all over the world. They swim at a speed of 20 kilometers per hour, but can go as fast as 50 kilometers per hour. Blue whales are one of the loudest animals on the planet. Most blue whales live for between 80 and 90 years.
