



DO YOU REMEMBER SENTENCE STRUCTURE?

Positive: subject + verb + complements.

(Unless the verb is an imperative. In this case, there won't be a subject)

Negative: subject + auxiliary + not + verb + complements

(Auxiliary: do/did, am, is, are/was, were; have, has/had; will/would; can/could)

Interrogative: (wh- word) + auxiliary + subject + verb + complements?

(Unless we ask about the subject, but don't worry about this by now).

Let's order these sentences now:

2 are / going / when / the / help / vet / you / to / ?

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3 has / the / to / every day / bears / feed / she
