Simple present with fixed times

Preposition of time: **at**

Questions

What time **does** it **start**?

What time **does** it **end**?

Answers

It **starts at** 11:30 A.M.

It **ends at** 5 P.M.

Verbs usually followed by fixed times

• start • end • open • close • leave • arrive

Note

A.M. = morning; P.M. = afternoon/night
