 Jake **won't (will not)** go to the party. (negative)

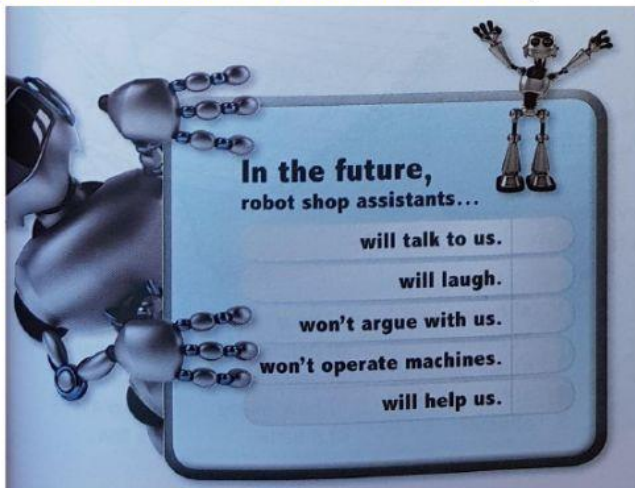

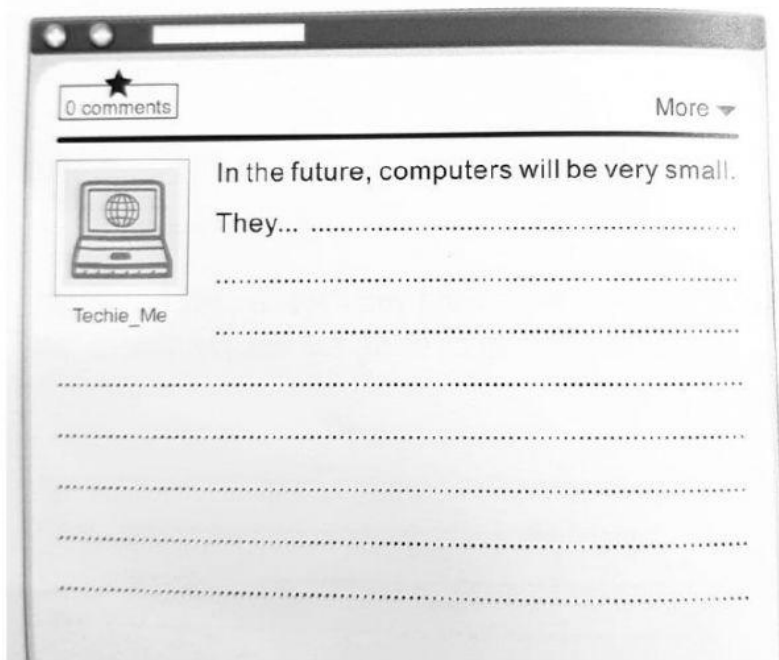
