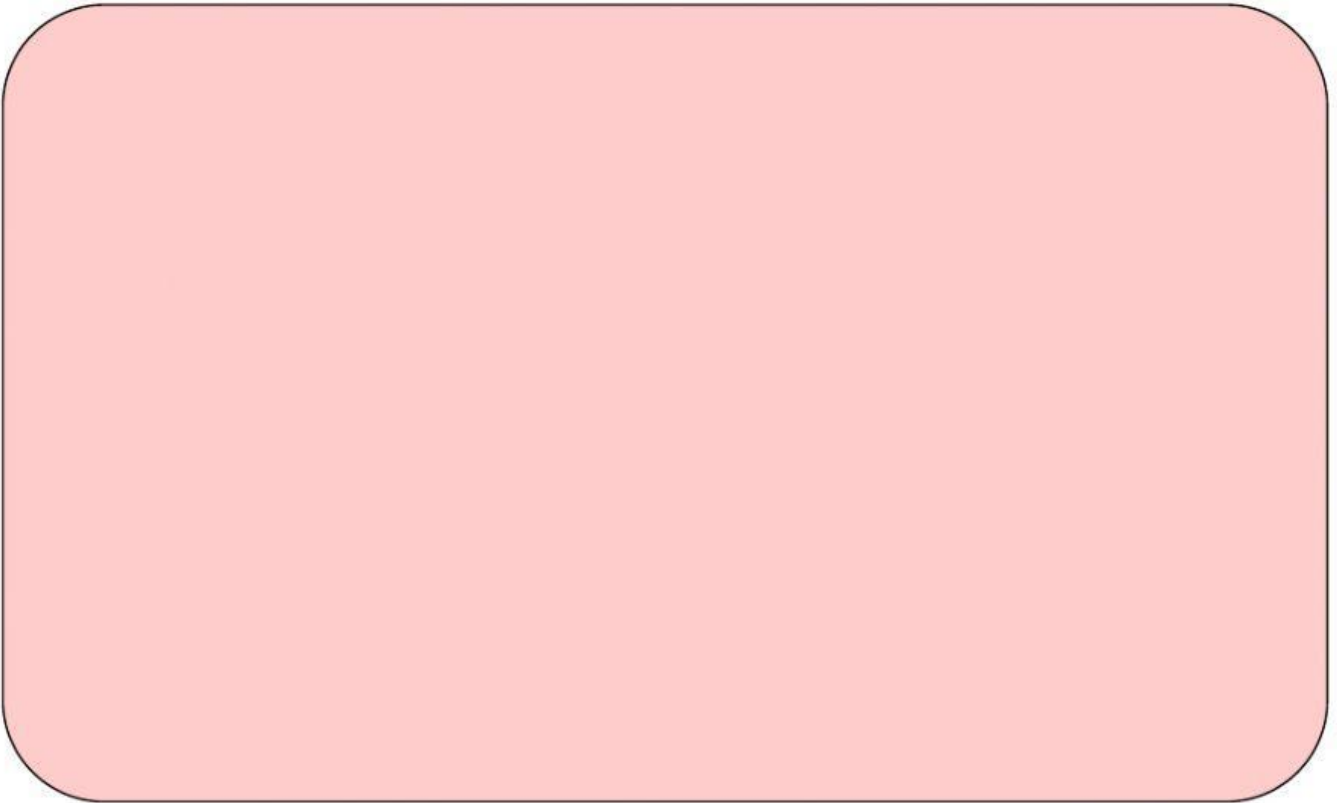

Operating temperature **range**: +10°C to +85°C

AVP 345005. **Plastic (mylar) capacitor**.
Non-polarized polyester film (mylar) **insulator** and
metal **plates** encased within a hard epoxy coating.
Coating protects against moisture. Designed for use in
general purpose DC applications.
Capacity: 0.0047 μf (microfarad)
Voltage rating: 100V
Operating temperature range: -67°F to 185°F

AVE 304050. **Electrolytic capacitor**.

Aluminum capacitors designed for applications needing
high capacitance, low cost, and very small size such
as in personal computers and medical electronics.
Capacitance : 22 μf (microfarad)
Voltage rating: 50V
Operating temperature range: -40°F to 185°F
