

5 Types of Nouns



Select the correct noun type for each definition.

Nouns that start with a capital letter, gives an exact name.

Nouns that cannot be seen, heard, felt, smelled, touched, or tasted.

Nouns that represent a large group (can be singular or plural).

Regular nouns, not specific names, you don't know which one exactly.

Nouns that you experience through your 5 senses (most nouns).
