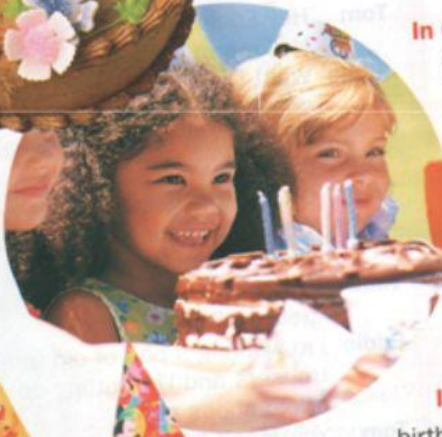


Read the text
