ACTIVITY 1: Match the actions with the verbs in the box. Write them in the correct place. Use a dictionary.

ACTIVITY 2: Select "can" or "can't" to complete these sentences about materials.

Leer bien los ejemplos, entre parentesis hay tres palabras separadas por barras. La primera es el verbo (son todos de la actividad 1) y las palabras restantes son materiales. **Can** es positivo y significa **poder**, indica habilidad (can bend = podés doblar). **Can't** es negativo (can't bend = no podés doblar).

Examples:

1 (bend / metal / wood) You can bend metal, but you can't bend wood.

Podés doblar metal, pero no podés doblar madera.

2 (heat / air / water) You can heat air and you can heat water.

Podés calentar aire y podés calentar agua.

4 (scratch / glass / metal) You can't scratch glass and you can't scratch metal.

5 (stretch / nylon / glass) You can stretch nylon, but you can't stretch glass.

6 (bend / glass / wood) You can't bend glass, but you can bend wood.

7 (cut / wood / metal) You can cut wood and you can't cut metal.

8 (compress / air / glass) You can compress air, but you can't compress glass.
