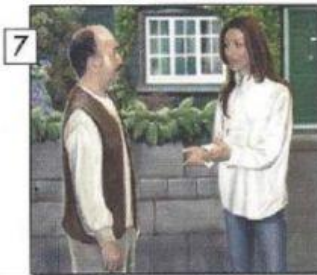
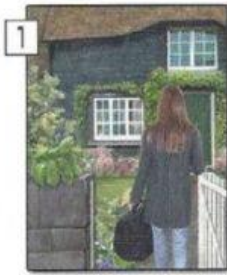


Storytelling Adverbs
