Looking at a set of **photos /symmetry** it's easy to say which faces we find **attractive/effects** .Different people will usually agree on which **faces/photos** those are.

Researchers/Population have some answers, like **symmetry/average**. Faces that we consider attractive tend to be symmetrical.

In a symmetrical face, the **left/up** and right sides look like each other. They're not **effects/perfect** mirror images. But our eyes read faces with similar proportions on **both/face** sides as symmetrical.

One of the researchers said "Averageness includes all kinds of factors, Such as the size of the features of your face and their arrangement."

For example, the distance between the centers of a woman's eyes affects if she is considered **beautiful/intelligent** People find her more attractive when that distance is very short. Researchers at the University of California, San Diego and the University of Toronto in Canada discovered that ratio, the **distance/average** between a woman's eyes and mouth, is also important.
