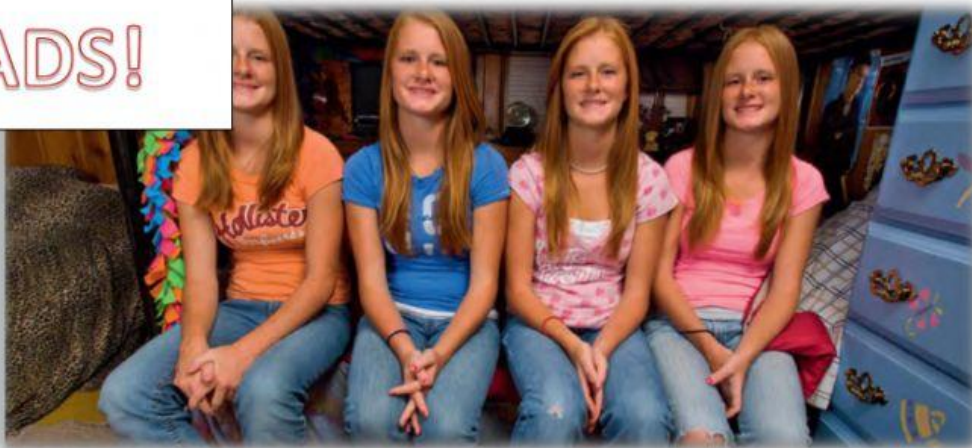


QUADS!



The Durst girls – Kendra, Megan, Calli and Sarah – from Buffalo, Minnesota, are extremely rare: they are identical quadruplets. There are only sixty sets of identical quads in the world, and the girls have been celebrities in the US since they were born, in February 1993. They have appeared on the *Oprah Winfrey Show*, and many other TV shows.

The girls look exactly the same – even they get confused and call each other the wrong name sometimes. All four have light brown hair and ‘thousands’ of freckles, and they are each about 150 cm tall. According to their English teacher, Alisa Ireland, ‘They are all beautiful. How is their mother going to cope ... with four beautiful teenage daughters?’

The girls also have similar sporting interests. All four play soccer, and Kendra, Megan and Sarah enjoy gymnastics, although Calli prefers basketball.

The girls all have very strong personalities and their teacher says they are very dominant at school. ‘The quads are really popular, everyone wants to be their friend,’ says Alisa. ‘They’ve become real leaders in their class ... but they’re all so different!’

According to friends and family, these days they don’t agree about anything. Calli, the tomboy* of the family, is the most argumentative, apparently. Kendra is very ‘girly’, her sisters say, she always wants things to be clean and nice, and Megan is the most sociable – she loves make-up, clothes, going out and shopping. Sarah is the shyest and most sensitive of the four and she is also the nicest, according to her sisters.

‘We don’t think of ourselves as quadruplets,’ says Megan. ‘We think of ourselves as four sisters who were born on the same day.’
