Flash mobbing



Sometimes a theater performance can happen when we are least expecting it.

Imagine sitting on a bus, (1).....you take every day to work, and suddenly all the passengers stand up and start dancing together. Or at the airport, imagine hundreds of people (2).....appear not to know each other singing a song all together. It is known as “flash mobbing” and it is an event in (3).....a group of people get together in a public place, perform an unusual act for a short time and then disappear as if nothing has happened. The people (4).....organize these flash mobs use telecommunications, social media and e-mails to invite others to participate.

Originally flash mobs were about entertainment, but in recent years many companies have started organizing them for advertising purposes (5).....has proved to be very successful. They select locations (6).....lots of people will be gathered, such as busy train stations or city squares, and surprise them with a sudden performance.

Advertisers know this will get a lot of attention at that moment, but also later when people upload videos online.
