

STORY: **PAST SIMPLE AND PAST CONTINUOUS**

We often use the **PAST SIMPLE** and the **PAST CONTINUOUS** in stories. They are usually combined with the words **when** or **while**. The **Past Continuous** is the action in progress that is interrupted by the main action in the **Simple Past**. The **Simple Past** shows an action or an event that happened in the middle of the longer action expressed by the **Past Continuous**.
