In the 1400's, merchants across Europe traveled to India but it was very dangerous. Christopher Columbus, an Italian explorer, wanted to find an easier way. He traveled west and stumbled across the Americas. His "discovery" opened up exploration and the colonization of the Americas.

After Christopher Columbus claimed America for Spain, many explorers came looking for gold and riches. They had heard a rumor about "seven cities of gold". Unfortunately, that was a myth so they never found any gold.

The English started coming to America as early as 1585. Many English were in search of religious freedom. The Church of England would persecute anyone who did not worship their religion, so many chose to leave and find a place where they could worship freely.

The French king sent explorers to America to find a passage that would lead west, all the way to Asia. Although the passage was never found, they were able to claim additional land in the name of France and started a profitable fur trade with the Native Americans.
