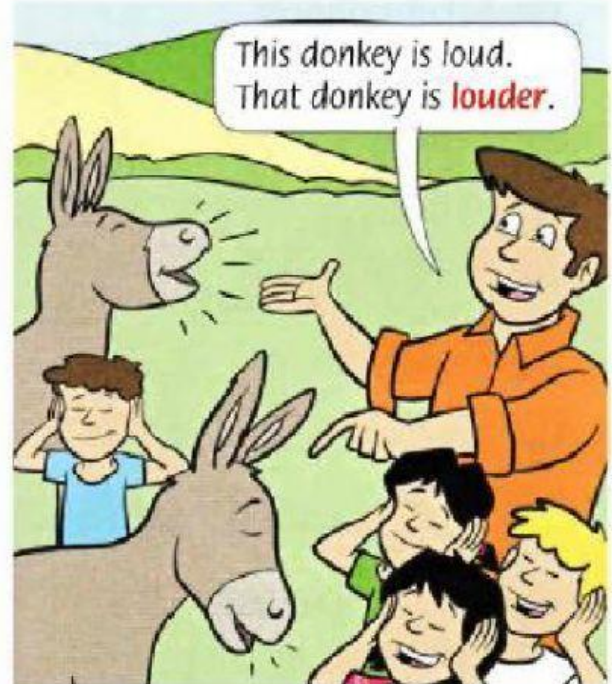
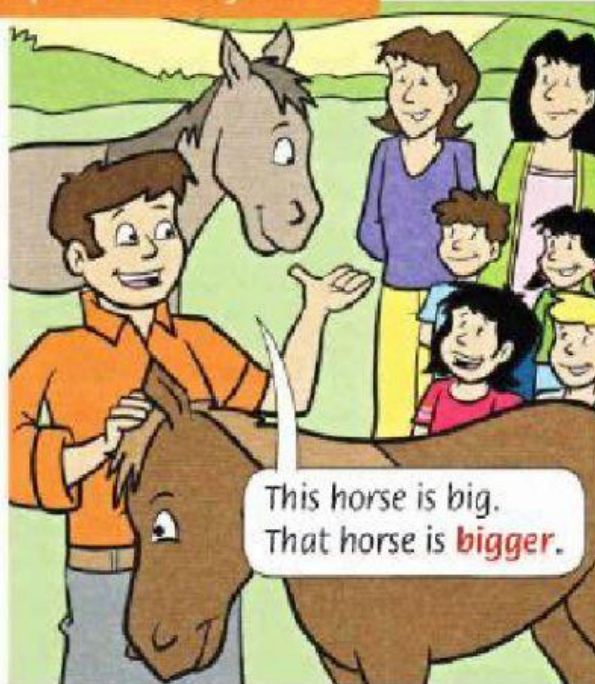




Comparative adjectives

Comparative adjectives



Big and **loud** are adjectives. Adjectives describe things or people.
Bigger and **louder** are comparative adjectives. We use comparative adjectives to describe the difference between two things or people.

We make the comparative by adding **er** to the end of the adjective.

small → smaller loud → louder quiet → quieter
fast → faster slow → slower

Be careful. Sometimes the spelling changes.

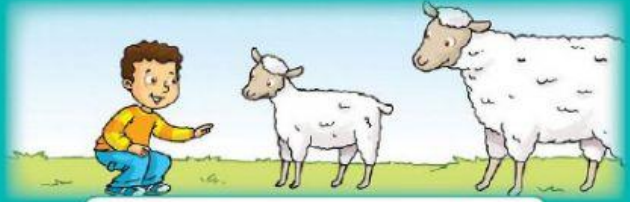
big + g + er → bigger

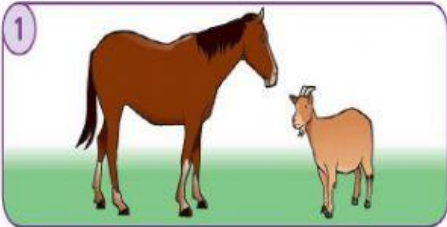

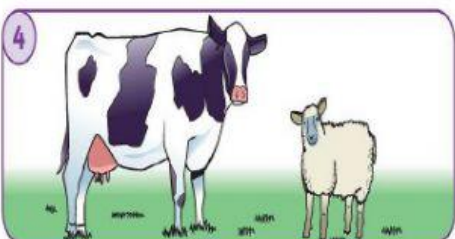
