George Orwell

George Orwell was a well-known English novelist, essayist and critic. He is famous for his novels *Animal Farm* and *Nineteen Eighty-Four*.

George Orwell was born Eric Arthur Blair in Motihari, Bengal, India, in 1903. One year after he was born, his mother _____ him and his older sister, Marjorie, to England.

He started school at a place called St. Cyprian's. He didn't like studying there. He _____ that the teachers were nicer to richer students than to poorer students. He wasn't popular and he found comfort in adventure books.

After finishing his studies at Eton University, he joined the India Imperial Police and spent five years in Burma. When he returned to England, he decided to become a writer. He published his first full-length work, *Down and Out in Paris and London*, in 1933, and his first novel, *Burmese Days*, in 1934. Around this time, he _____ Eileen O'Shaughnessy. The couple married in June 1936.

In December 1936, Orwell travelled to Spain, where he joined one of the groups fighting against General Francisco Franco in the Spanish Civil War. He got shot in the throat and arm and could not speak for a few weeks. He _____ about his experiences in Spain in *Homage to Catalonia* (1938).

In 1945, Orwell published one of his most famous books, *Animal Farm*. The book was an anti-Soviet satire that shows the horrors of Stalinism. In the book, real people are represented by various kinds of animals. The communist officials are represented by pigs. The book was successful and it _____ Orwell famous. In 1949, he published *Nineteen Eighty-Four*, another novel warning against totalitarianism. The phrase "Big Brother is watching you" comes from this book. Both *Animal Farm* and *Nineteen Eighty-Four* have been turned into films.

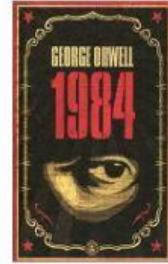
