There was / There were (ед. ч.) (мн. ч.)	Указывают на наличие чего-либо в прошедшем времени. Переводятся с конца.
There was a box on the table. <i>На столе была коробка.</i> There were two pens in the box. <i>В коробке было два карандаша.</i> There was some water in the glass. <i>В стакане было немного воды.</i>	<i>С неисчисляемыми существительными всегда</i> There was (ед. ч.)

There was not = there wasn't
 There were not = there weren't

Утверждение	Вопрос	Отрицание
There was a pen... There were two pens...	Was there a pen...? Were there two pens...?	There wasn't a pen... There weren't pens...

!!! Выбор единственного или множественного числа конструкций **There is (was) / There are (were)** зависит от числа первого существительного.

There is a table and two chairs in the room.
There are two chairs and a table in the room.
There was a pen and six pencils on the table.
There were six pencils and a pen on the table.
