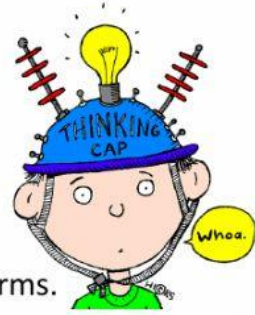


## SIMPLE PRESENT
