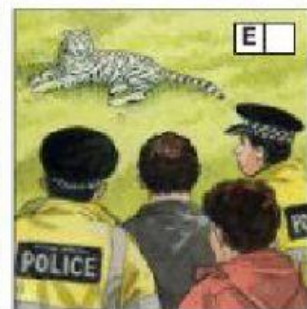
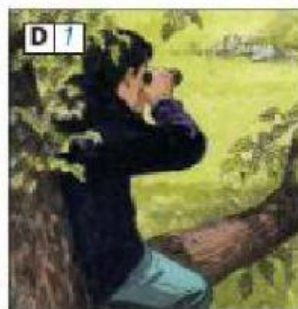
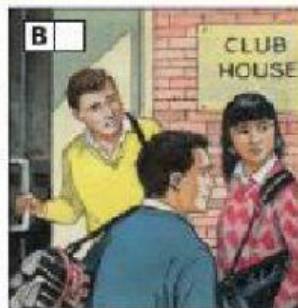
This is a true story.

-ED, -D OR, -IED

SPELLING RULES

Past simple of regular verbs: affirmative and negative

Affirmative

They **noticed** a strange animal.
A police car **arrived**.
The players **stopped** their games.

Negative

They **didn't notice** a strange animal.
A police car **didn't arrive**.
The players **didn't stop** their games.

REGULAR VERBS SPELLING RULES

Most verbs... + **ed**

visit - visited
start - started
watch - watched
rain - rained
finish - finished
listen - listened
work - worked
walk - walked
want - wanted

Verbs ending in e...+**d**

like - liked
arrive - arrived
dance - danced
live - lived
love - loved
close - closed
taste - tasted
use - used

Verbs ending: vowel + y... +**ed**

play - played
enjoy - enjoyed
stay - stayed

Verbs ending: consonant + y... +**ied**

study - studied
cry - cried
try - tried

One syllable verbs... double the last consonant...

stop - stopped
plan - planned

travel - travelled
