

Measurement

Change litre into millilitre.

1. $1\text{ l} = \underline{1000}\text{ ml}$
2. $7\text{ l} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
3. $5\text{ l} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
4. $9\text{ l} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
5. $4\text{ l} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$

Change millilitre into litre

1. $6000\text{ ml} = 6\text{ l}$
2. $2000\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ l}$
3. $8000\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ l}$
4. $9000\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ l}$

Note:

$1000\text{ ml} = 1\text{ litre}$

1. Complete the following. First one is done for you.

- i) $5\text{ l} + 376\text{ ml} = 5000\text{ ml} + 376\text{ ml} = 5376\text{ ml}$
- ii) $3\text{ l} + 735\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
- iii) $4\text{ l} + 43\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
- iv) $8\text{ l} + 6\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
- v) $6\text{ l} + 800\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}\text{ ml}$
