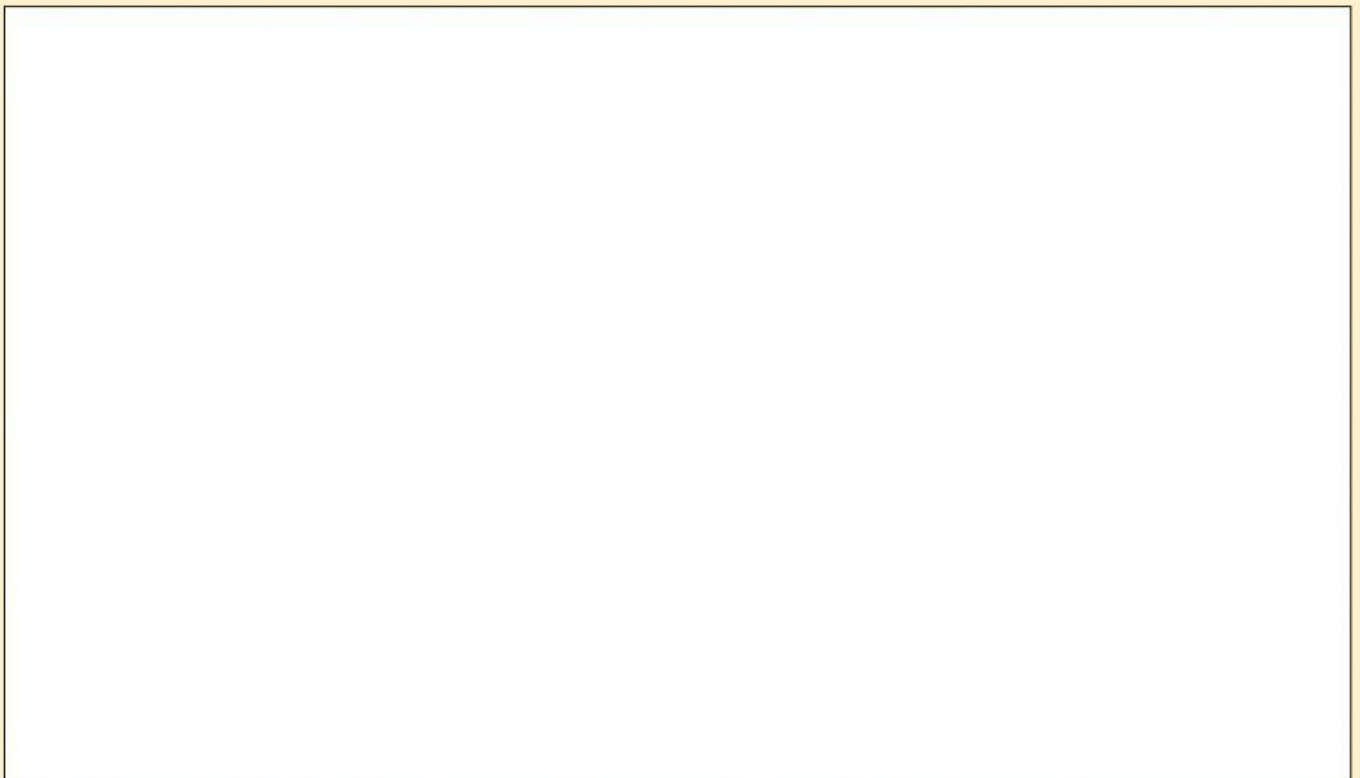


LIVING ROOMS ALL OVER THE WORLD
