

Interrogative Sentences

Present Simple

Do + I/we/you/they + verb in base form
Does + he/she/it + verb in base form

Do you finish the assignment?
Does he finish the assignment?
Do they finish the assignment?

Past Simple

Did + I, we/you/they + verb in base form
Did + he/she/it + verb in base form

Did I finish the assignment?
Did he finish the assignment?
Did they finish the assignment?

Future Will

Will + I, we/you/they + verb in base form
Will + he/she/it + verb in base form

Will I finish the assignment tonight?
Will he finish the assignment tonight?
Will they finish the assignment tonight?

Future Going To

Am + I + going to + verb in base form
Is + he/she/it + going to + verb in base form
Are + we/you/they + going to + verb in base form

Am I going to finish the assignment?
Is he going to finish the assignment?
Are they going to finish the assignment?
