

Interrogative Verb Tenses

Present Simple Interrogative

- ❖ Use **do** and **does**
- ✚ **Do** for **I, we, you, they**
- ✚ **Does** for **he, she it**

Examples:

Do **they** have lunch at home?
Does **he** bake cookies?
Do **you** have a car?

Simple Past Interrogative

- ❖ Use **did**
- ✚ **Did** for **I, we, you, they**
- ✚ **Did** for **he, she it**

Examples:

Did **they** have lunch at home?
Did **he** bake cookies?
Did **you** have a car?

Future Simple Interrogative

- ❖ Use **will**
- ✚ **Will** for **I, we, you, they**
- ✚ **Will** for **he, she it**

Examples:

Will **they** have lunch at home?
Will **he** bake cookies?
Will **you** have a car?

Future «going to» Interrogative

- ❖ Use **am, is, are**
- ✚ **Am** for **I**
- ✚ **Is** for **he, she it**
- ✚ **Are** for **we, you, they**

Examples:

Are **they** going to have lunch at home?
Is **he** going to bake cookies?
Am **I** going to have a car?
