



Simple Past

Affirmative

Subject + regular / irregular verb +

Examples: I **WENT** to the beach last summer

She **PLAYED** hockey last year.

Negative

Subject + **DIDN'T / DID NOT** + infinitive verb

Examples: I **DIDN'T GO** to the beach last summer

She **DIDN'T PLAY** hockey last year.

Interrogative

DID + Subject + infinitive verb + ... + ?

Examples: **DID** YOU **GO** to the beach last summer?

DID She **PLAY** hockey last year?

short answers

Yes, subject **DID** / No, subject + **didn't**

Examples: yes, I **DID** / No, I **DIDN'T**

Yes, she **DID** / No, she **DIDN'T**
