


# POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES


- We use possessive adjectives to tell to whom something belongs. When something belongs to a man/boy we use *his*.  
→ Pete finished *his* homework.
- Use *her* when something belongs to woman/girl.  
→ Mary is talking to *her* mother.
- Use *its* when something belongs to singular things/animals.  
The cat scratched the child with *its* claws.
- *Your* is used when things belong to the addressed person/s.  
→ Bob! Where are you? I hear *your* voice but can't see you.
- Use *our* when something belongs to the speakers.  
→ Our house is very big.
- *Their* is used when something belongs to a group of people, animals or things.  
→ The children went to *their* school.
- Possessive adjectives are always followed by nouns.  
→ *My* shoes are new.
