- We use possessive adjectives to tell to whom something belongs. When something belongs to a man/boy we use **his**.
➔ Pete finished **his** homework.
- Use **her** when something belongs to woman/girl.
➔ Mary is talking to **her** mother.
- Use **its** when something belongs to singular things/animals.
The cat scratched the child with **its** claws.
- **Your** is used when things belong to the addressed person/s.
➔ Bob! Where are you? I hear **your** voice but can't see you.
- Use **our** when something belongs to the speakers.
➔ Our house is very big.
- **Their** is used when something belongs to a group of people, animals or things.
➔ The children went to **their** school.
- Possessive adjectives are always followed by nouns.
➔ **My** shoes are new.

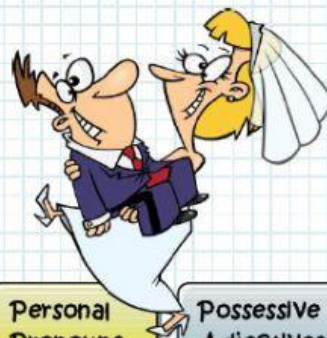

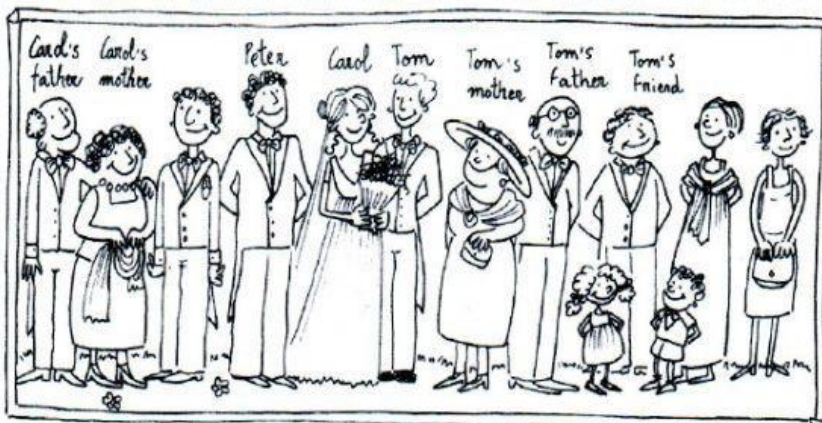
