<b>When</b>	Jim <b>knocked</b> the door	,	I <b>was watching</b> TV
	Jim <b>knocked</b> the door	<b>while</b>	I <b>was watching</b> TV
<b>While</b>	I <b>was watching</b> TV	,	Jim <b>knocked</b> the door
