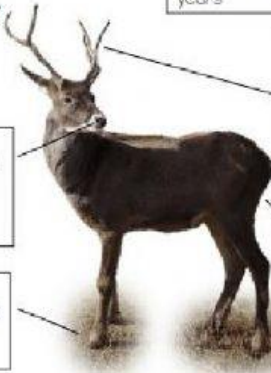
# REINDEER
