

Past Participle: Regular and Irregular verbs

- ⇒ The past participle of the verbs is called V3 too.
- ⇒ The ending of these verbs in Spanish is : ado, ido, to , so, cho. Example: swam= nadado, written= escrito, printed= impreso, gone= ido, done= hecho.
- ⇒ El pasado participio de los verbos es llamado también V3 (verbo forma 3) . El V1 es verbo en presente, el V2 es el verbo en pasado y ahora el V3 es en pasado participio.
- ⇒ One way to know the ending of the verbs in spanish is to conjugate them. For example:
I have written many letters. → Yo he escrito muchas cartas.
