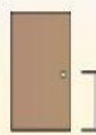

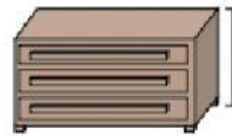
Millimeter (mm)	Centimeter (cm)	Meter (m)	Kilometer (km)
