Look at the following table about OBJECT PRONOUNS.

SUBJECT PRONOUNS	OBJECT PRONOUNS
I -	→ me
you -	→ you
he -	→ him
she 💳	→ her
it -	→ it
we -	→ us
they -	→ them



Object Pronouns substitute a noun / expression that is the Object of a sentence.

- These Pronouns are placed after the verb: Mary loves Peter. = Mary loves him.
- Object Pronouns can follow a preposition: She thinks about Peter.
  - = She thinks about him.
