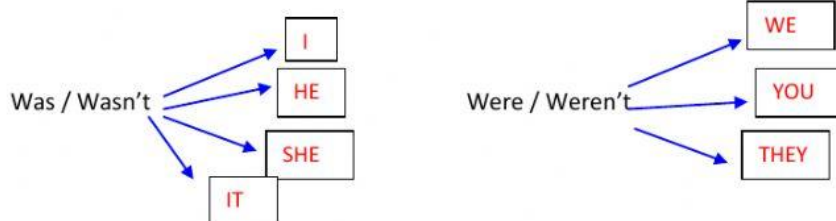


Celebrations

Past Simple verb TO BE

Remember we use WAS/WASN'T or WERE/WEREN'T:
