3) Luis has $\frac{1}{2}$ pound of bird seed left to share equally among 4 bird cages in his shop. How many pounds can he put in each bird cage?	4) Robert's lemon cookie recipe calls for $\frac{1}{3}$ cup sugar. How much sugar would Robert use to make $\frac{1}{2}$ of a batch of cookies?
5) Mr. Lee bought a block of fudge that weighed $\frac{1}{2}$ pound. He cut it into 5 equal pieces. What was the weight of each piece of fudge?	6) The elephants at the Zoo are fed $\frac{1}{2}$ a barrel of corn each day. The buffalo are fed $\frac{2}{5}$ as much corn as the elephants. How many barrels of corn are the buffalo fed each day?
