




Comparative adjectives

Remember!

We use **COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES** to compare two people or things.

We use the comparative of an adjective by adding **-er** to the end of the adjective and **"than"**



	small	smaller
	loud	louder
	quiet	quieter
	fast	faster
	slow	slower
	old	older
	young	younger
	tall	taller
	short	shorter


