



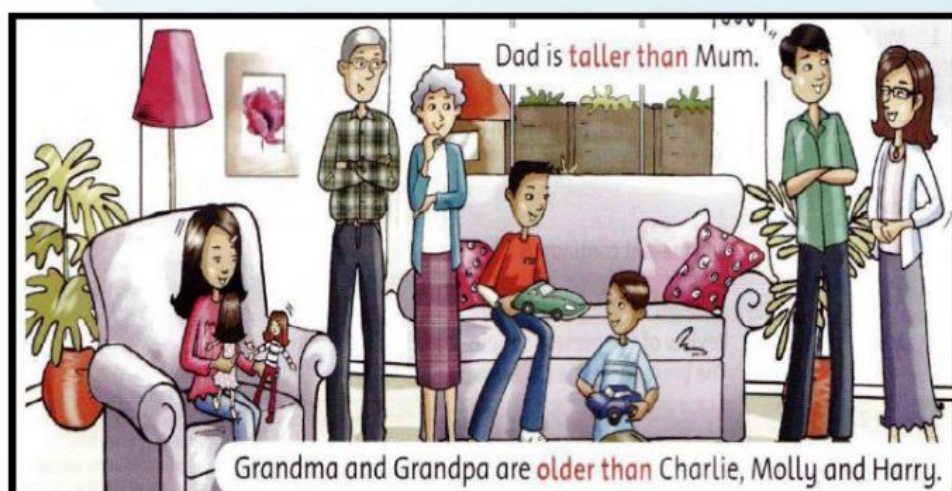

Remember!

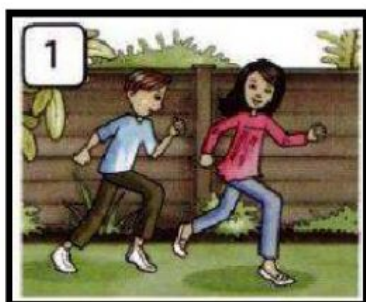
We use **COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES** to compare two people or things.

short	shorter

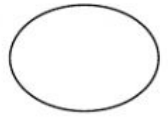
